It is hereby informed to all concerned students of HS 2nd Year that, as per ASSEB Notification No. ASSEB/DIV-II/R&A/PORT-NOTF/2026/53/2334 dated 28/04/2026, all unsuccessful candidates of HS Final Examination from the year 2022 to 2026 must take re-admission as Regular Students in HS 2nd Year.

All such students are directed to complete their re-admission process within the stipulated period to be notified by the college office. Failing to take re-admission will render them ineligible to appear in the forthcoming HS Final Examination.

However, students who are not willing to take re-admission as Regular Students may opt to enroll in the Assam State Open School as an alternative.

NOTIFICATION

Presently, the students who desire to reappear in Higher Secondary Final Examination for betterment etc., they have to appear as IP or NIP candidates, which creates a confusion regarding the status of the students. In order to avoid such confusion and streamline the process, the Board has decided to do away with this provision. Accordingly, **it is notified herewith for information of all concerned that all unsuccessful candidates of HIS final Examination, 2026, have to take re-admission as Regular student in HIS 2nd Year and thereby they can be treated at par with regular candidate.**

Accordingly, to execute the re-admission process and to ensure that the students meet the eligibility criteria to appear in the HIS Final Examination, 2027, the following guidelines have been formulated.

1. The unsuccessful students of the HIS Final Examination from the year 2022 to 2026, as mentioned in point 3 below, have to take re-admission in HIS 2nd Year. Such students have to opt for subjects as per subject combination given in Academic Regulation of ASSEB, Div-II issued vide No- ASSEB/ DIV-II/ COURSE/ CURRICULA/ 2025/ 007/ 558 dated 24/04/2025 since the HIS Final Examination, 2027 will be held as per such subject combination with six compulsory subjects. In case of any difficulty in taking re-admission in the existing institution, the student will be able to take re-admission in any other institutions, as per convenience.
2. All the re-admitted students must have to compulsorily appear in the Half Yearly Examination and Unit Test (as applicable) to become eligible as Regular Student for the HIS Final Examination, 2027 provided, if the student does not want to take re-admission then he/she can enroll in Assam State Open School.
3. From 2027, a Special Examination will be conducted within two months from the date of declaration of results of the main examination.
  - a) The students, who appeared in five subjects and declared failed in one subject or the students, who appeared in six subjects and declared failed in two subjects in the results of HIS Final Examination 2026, will have to appear in this Special Examination 2027, without taking fresh admission.
  - b) The passed students of HIS Final Examination 2026 and 2027 will get chance to re-appear for the betterment of the results in the Special Examination, 2027 for all the subjects, in which the candidate desires to appear.
4. From this year onwards, skill proficiency certificate shall be issued separately to all the students who have appeared in skill based subjects in the HIS Final examination.
5. Earlier, there was ambiguity in the passing marks assigned to different subjects, as the criteria varied across disciplines and subjects. To address the lack of uniformity often led to confusion and perceptions of inconsistency and to establish a more transparent


and equitable system, a standardized pattern has now been introduced. As such a student must have to appear in all the Six (6) subjects and securing of 33% of mark in aggregate is compulsory. However, if a student fails in one (1) Elective subject and gets pass mark in rest of the three (3) Elective subjects, he/she will be declared as pass. For certification passing in English and MII/Alt. English is compulsory.

N.B: A portal for re-admission in IIS 2<sup>nd</sup> Year will be opened after two weeks of declaration of results of IIS Final Examination, 2026, with an option to change the institution, if desire. Further, details of this portal will be notified in due course of time.


