Marking Pattern for Speech Competition

A uniform 100-mark evaluation framework may be adopted:

Criterion	Marks
Relevance and understanding of the topic	25
Content and quality of ideas	20
Organisation and logical presentation	15
Originality and analytical ability	15
Delivery, confidence and articulation	15
Language and communication	5
Adherence to prescribed time	5
Total	100

The same broad evaluation framework should be followed at all levels to ensure consistency.

7. SUGGESTED QUIZ FORMAT

The exact format may be decided by the organising authority; however, the following format may be adopted:

Round 1 – Preliminary Round

- Multiple-choice questions.
- Questions covering general knowledge and the designated themes.
- Top-performing teams shall qualify for the next round.

Round 2 – General Knowledge Round

Questions may cover:

- Seva Sankalp Abhiyan
- Assam
- Indian history and culture
- Geography
- Science and technology
- Constitution and civic awareness
- Sports
- Current affairs
- Art, literature and heritage

Round 3 – Thematic/Visual Round

Questions based on:

- Images
- Personalities
- Places
- Symbols
- Historical events
- Important institutions or achievements

Round 4 – Rapid-Fire/Buzzer Round

- Teams shall answer questions within a prescribed time.
- The scoring and negative-marking rules, if any, shall be announced before commencement.

The organising authority may modify the number and nature of rounds according to the age group and level of competition.
